Update - change in supply & order codes for Nutriprem 2 (800g powder & 200ml liquid) (hospital orders):

Nutriprem 2 formats - 800g powder & 200ml liquid only - have been delisted from NHS Supply Chain, therefore if the hospital purchases these for babies going home from the neonatal unit, they will need to be ordered via AAH.

As AAH routinely supply all hospitals with other products & consumables etc., this shouldn't create any difficulties. The following codes may help for reference when ordering either of these Nutriprem 2 formats from AAH - item code is our code, the link code is AAH's code :
