There is an expected national shortage of Gentamicin 20 mg in 2 mL injection.

A National Medicines Shortage Notice is being finalised and will be circulated imminently

After discussion we advise that the adult strength gentamicin injection (80 mg in 2 mL) can be used for neonatal patients but should be diluted to 10 mg in 1mL before administration.

The recommendation is to dilute in a standard manner i.e. prepare a 10mg in 1mL solution before measuring the dose.

The dilution steps have been included in the paediatric gentamicin monograph on MEDUSA.
